## Who can Apply to DAWERR Year 2?

Municipalities with the following eligibility criteria:

- Availability of land (a minimum of 1000 m²) with proof of ownership or lease agreement extending over a minimum of five years, to be used for project
- Resident population of at least 7,000 individuals and/or a minimum of 6 tons of waste generated daily
- Demonstrated experience in Solid Waste Management projects. Activities or initiatives
- Willingness to establish a Municipal Solid Waste Management Committee (including representatives of Civil Society Organizations), with defined roles and responsibilities
- Willingness to allocate an average of 30 hours per month (over one year) to the project (across multiple committee members)
